| 1. Where will the scores be posted? | 1. Scores will be posted on each school's website and each school will leave a message on their voicemail system. Websites and phone number information will be handed out the day of tryouts. |
| 2. Where will VHS be having clinic? | 2. Vandegrift will go to Cedar Park HS for their clinic. |
| 3. Can we turn in the paperwork at anytime, as long as it is by March 23? | 3. Yes, paperwork can be turned into the designated location anytime before the deadline. |
| 4. Since the middle school students cannot get to the maximum points of 110 for GPA, what will you do? | 4. The maximum score for middle school students is 18, since middle school students do not compete against high school students; they are all on a level playing field. |
| 5. Are the tardies and GPA calculated for 1 semester or a full year? | 5. Tardies will be for the full year up until March 23 rd . For high schools it is a cumulative GPA that has been calculated up until the end of the first semester. For middle schools it is for the first semester of their 8 th grade year. |
| 6. What is considered "current" for the physicals? | 6. A current physical is one that doesn't expire before the deadline date or tryout date. If it is not current up to the deadline date, then you will have to get a new one for the clinic and tryout. |
| 7. If my student goes to a private school right now, how will you get her GPA? | 7. We will call their current school to obtain any necessary information. |
| 8. If my student's physical expires on March 24 th , what do I need to do? | 8. If your physical expires after the deadline you must provide a new physical the first day of the clinic. Please turn in the current physical on the deadline date. |
| 9. How are absences calculated (excused and unexcused)? | 9. Absence points are based on hours owed. |
| 10. Is the pricing for cheer based on new members? | 10. Pricing is based on a member that would have to purchase everything (new member). A returning member wouldn't necessarily have to purchase items that they already have. |
| 11. Is there a scholarship fund that parents can donate to who want to help other parents/students defray the costs of cheer? | 11. There are not any scholarships available through LISD. You would have to check with your school booster club if they offer any scholarships. |
| 12. On the Important Date's pages, when do you anticipate announcing the TBA dates for camps? | 12. Each campus attends a different camp. Please check with your campus' coach to obtain the dates. |
| 13. Will the coaches give the parents a copy of | 13. Each coach will give the current members of |

| 14. If I didn't pay for the tryout uniform at the parent night, how will I pay for it? | 14. You can pay for the tryout uniform when you turn in all your paperwork. Please note that receipts will not be given until the first day of the clinic. |
| 15. What is considered an "expired physical?" | 15. An expired physical is one that is dated before the due date of the paperwork. |
| 16. Where do the 8 th graders turn in their packets? | 16. All 8 th graders are required to turn in their paperwork at the high school that they will be trying out for, in the designated location. |
| 17. The Important Dates—how firm are they? | 17. Please talk with your campus coach as to the flexibility of the Important Dates page. |
| 18. My student is taking classes at ACC. How do I get those classes counted into her GPA? | 18. ACC classes do not count towards GPA. |
